Local fire and emergency services, with region-wide enhanced 9-1-1.

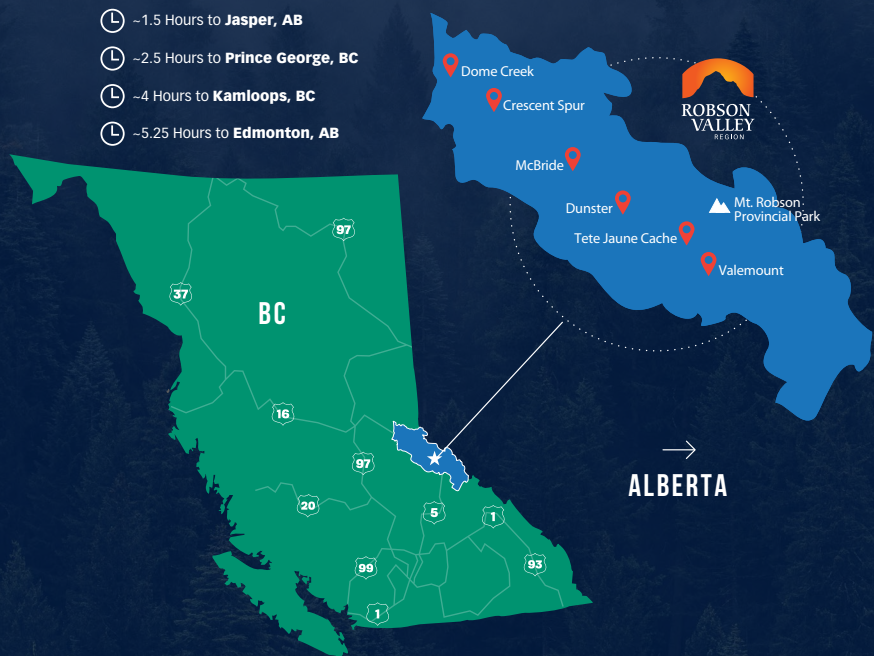
Recreation and Cultural Facilities
